
The **MISSION** of the Forum is to support and advocate on behalf of the ESRD Networks in promoting methods to improve the quality of care to patients with renal disease.

- Strategic Partnerships
 - Continued collaboration with CMS, NKF, RPA, and other stakeholders
 - Met with VA to discuss possible collaboration
 - Continued development of new toolkits
- Board Development
 - Began development of member questionnaire to gauge areas of interest/expertise
- Customer Outreach, Sharing, & Engagement
 - Implemented social media plans for 2023 and 2024
 - Rolled out Kidney Month campaign via social media in March 2024

Highlights from March 2024 Meeting

- President Dr. Kam Kalantar presented his President's Report, including information on the Forum's solid relationship with CMS colleagues and highlighting Forum activities, such as toolkits and publications.
- KPAC Interim Co-Chair Mary Baliker shared information about Kidney Month and the social media campaign the KPAC developed.
- EDAC Chair Vicky Cash shared updates on the Networks' contract performance to-date, noting that Networks are performing well on the transplantation measures and the transition to home dialysis measure. She also noted challenges to some of the measures, citing data issues and apathy toward vaccination among staff and patients.
- MAC Chair Dan Landry shared that the MAC continues work on its health equity toolkit, and the MAC is
 considering exhibiting its toolkits via Zoom to some fellowship programs. There has been a request to
 collaborate on a palliative care toolkit as well. The SHEP program has another approved submission,
 available on the Forum's website.
- Treasurer Stephanie Counter provided an overview of Forum finances in 2023, noting the impressive donations to the Derek Forfang Memorial Fund, which will fund KPAC activities.

Forum/CMS Communications



- On the January call with CMS, KPAC Co-Chair Dawn Edwards spoke about the need for staffassisted home dialysis. She noted that by providing support at home, it would give more patients the opportunity to get home and help patients who are home stay home.
- In February, the EDAC members reflected on the Network site visits with Melissa Dorsey. Ms. Dorsey also shared her experience with the site visits. The visits were mutually beneficial, with the Networks citing greater commitment to the work following Ms. Dorsey's visits.
- The March meeting focused on the ESRD Treatment Choices (ETC) Model with presentations from Dr. Amal Trivedi (Brown University School of Public Health) and Dr. Andy Howard (Forum Board). Both spoke about dialysis facility performance and outcomes under the model, with Dr. Trivedi focusing specifically on social risk.

What Else Has the Forum Been Doing?




- FOUR new Sharing Highly Effective Practices (SHEP) initiatives have been approved and posted to the <u>Forum website</u>. More highly effective practices are forthcoming.
- In February, the Forum sent a letter of support for dental services for ESRD patients to CMS.
- In March, Forum leadership met with representatives from the Veterans Administration to discuss possible collaborations.
- The Forum membership has produced publications on topics such a dialysis facility closures and vaccination (see next slide for details).
